Daniel Špička will talk about the theatres in Český Krumlov, Litomyšl, Valtice, Kačina, Mnichovo Hradiště and Žleby. He is a founder of CORA, the Centre for the Preservation and Restoration of Architecture, that has, among many other projects, documented and restored theatres and musical organs in Bohemia and Moravia. A specialist in restoring castle theatres, his latest project is the reconstruction of the Baroque theatre in Valtice to its original spatial and functional design. Opened in 2015, it can stage both historic and modern performances using the effects of authentic Baroque lighting and stage equipment.
